



## Prima Marine Group Climate and Decarbonization Position Statement

Prima Marine Public Company Limited and its Group companies (“Prima Marine”) recognize climate change as a material sustainability issue and are committed to supporting the transition toward a low-carbon economy. The Group’s climate commitments are aligned with the Paris Agreement, the International Maritime Organization (IMO) GHG Strategy, Thailand’s climate ambitions, and the Group’s target to achieve Carbon Neutrality for Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions by 2030 and Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.

### **Paris Agreement**

Prima Marine supports the objectives of the Paris Agreement and global efforts to limit the increase in average global temperature to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels. The Group also support global efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote low-carbon development in line with the Paris Agreement’s objective

### **Thailand’s Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs)**

Prima Marine supports Thailand’s Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and the country’s long-term climate ambitions to move toward a low- GHG emissions development pathway. The Group contributes to these ambitions through greenhouse gas emissions reduction, energy efficiency improvement, and the implementation of low-carbon solutions across its operations.

### **IMO Decarbonization and Maritime Transition**

Prima Marine supports the IMO’s strategy to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from international shipping and recognizes its importance in guiding the maritime transition. The group is committed to improving vessel energy efficiency and advancing practical decarbonization solutions across its maritime operations.

### **Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction and Energy Efficiency**

Prima Marine is committed to continuously improving energy efficiency and reducing greenhouse gas emissions through operational optimization, energy management, fuel efficiency initiatives, and regular monitoring of environmental performance to support its GHG emissions reduction objectives.

### **Alternative Fuels and Decarbonization Technologies**

Prima Marine supports the development and adoption of alternative fuels, low-carbon technologies, and innovative solutions that contribute to greenhouse gas emissions reduction and long-term maritime decarbonization.



### Climate Policy Engagement

Prima Marine considers constructive climate policy engagement with governments, regulators, industry associations, and other stakeholders to promote climate-related policies, regulations, and initiatives that are aligned with the Paris Agreement, the IMO decarbonization agenda, and the Group’s climate commitments.

### Carbon Credits and Carbon Offset Mechanisms

The Group may utilize carbon credits in accordance with internationally recognized standards and applicable regulatory frameworks to support its Carbon Neutrality and Net Zero commitments.
